We build monuments to heroes and museums to display artifacts belonging to the great men and women of past ages. Well, we understand the saints to be members of our family and heroes of our faith. We venerate their relics as a way of giving thanks to God for their witness of holiness and as a reminder that Heaven is attainable for us too, as long as we open our hearts to God's grace as did the saints who have gone before us.
