This Sunday we celebrate the solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. The Church's teaching about the Trinity might seem complicated or technical, but it's one of the most fundamental elements of our Catholic faith. We invoke the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit so often—practically every time we begin and end a prayer—that it can become very routine and familiar to us, but it's an expression of a very important insight into God's own inner life, which He has revealed to us in Jesus Christ. In fact, the Son of God became man precisely in order to draw us deeply into that divine life. The Most Holy Trinity is no longer distant or impenetrable to us, because through our union with Christ we have been gathered into the intimate communion of life and love between the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Today's feast reminds us that God is not abstract or impersonal. He loves us and shares His life with us even now and calls us to share it fully in eternity.
