## **Parish News**

Today, the fourth Sunday of Easter, is traditionally known as Good Shepherd Sunday, because the Gospel reading today is always taken from the tenth chapter of John's Gospel, in which Jesus describes Himself as the Good Shepherd, who gathers and protects and lays down His life for His sheep. Some of the earliest artistic depictions of the Lord are those that show Him as the Good Shepherd; this is an image of Christ that's resonated with the hearts of Christians since the beginning.

And our Gospel reading this Sunday helps us to see why that is. The Lord says, "The shepherd calls his own sheep by name. . . . He walks ahead of them, and the sheep follow him, because they recognize his voice." God is not distant and abstract, nor is He indifferent to us and our needs. We are His. He knows us, is personally invested in us, loves us, and is willing even to die for us. He is our Good Shepherd, who Himself leads us to eternal pastures in His Kingdom.

Because of today's association with the image of Christ the Good Shepherd, this Sunday is also the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. Let's pray today that the Lord will continue to call men from our parish and diocese to serve Him as priests, to become good shepherds after the pattern of Christ by knowing, loving, and sacrificing for the flock entrusted to them by God.
