Parish News

The month of June has long been dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This devotion, which sees the physical heart of Christ as a manifestation of His divine love, should inspire us towards greater humility and love ourselves. The Sacred Heart of Jesus reminds us that God is not too great to care for us, but rather that His greatness is revealed precisely in His willingness to stoop down to us and give Himself away in love.

In a homily on the feast of the Sacred Heart, Pope Benedict XVI said, "I am not abandoned, adrift in the universe and in a society that leaves me ever more lost and bewildered. God looks after me. He is not a distant God, for whom my life is worthless. . . . There is a God who knows me, loves me, and is concerned about me." What an extraordinary thing that is: that the God of all creation should take such a personal and intimate interest in the lives of His creatures, that He should be so "meek and humble of heart," in the words of the Gospel, as to come down into the smallness of our lives and offer us the immensity of His love.

In a culture that so often celebrates pride and self-interest over humility and sacrifice, we Catholics are called to offer a clear and consistent witness to Christ by conforming ourselves to Him and showing to the whole world the holiness and love that flow from His Sacred Heart. As we make our way through this month dedicated to the Lord's Sacred Heart, we might make this old prayer our own: "O Jesus, meek and humble of heart, make my heart like unto Thine. Amen."
