## Parish News

Today, March 19, is the Solemnity of St. Joseph, Husband of the Blessed Virgin Mary, which is the patronal feast of our parish. Since it falls on a Sunday of Lent this year, our liturgical celebration of St. Joseph moves to the following Monday. So this week is an opportunity for us to reflect upon and strive to imitate St. Joseph's example of faith and humility. Whenever God called Joseph, he rose and went. He set aside his own plans, his own safety, and even his own understanding in order to follow unreservedly the path that the Lord had traced out for him. The Lord calls to all of us too to follow him in our own way, to walk with Him in faith and humility within the particular circumstances of our own lives. Let's ask St. Joseph to help us to follow his example by welcoming Christ into our lives with undivided hearts and allowing Him to guide and direct us in all that we do.

In his apostolic letter *Patris corde*, Pope Francis shared a prayer to St. Joseph, which the Holy Father had composed. Let's make it our own as we celebrate his feast day:

Hail, Guardian of the Redeemer,  
Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary.  
To you God entrusted His only Son;  
in you Mary placed her trust;  
with you Christ became man.

Blessed Joseph, to us too,  
show yourself a father  
and guide us in the path of life.  
Obtain for us grace, mercy, and courage,  
and defend us from every evil. Amen.
