This coming Wednesday, March 19, is the Solemnity of St. Joseph, Husband of the Blessed Virgin Mary, which is the patronal feast of our parish. So this week is an opportunity for us to reflect upon and strive to imitate St. Joseph's example of faith and humility. Whenever God called Joseph, he rose and went. He set aside his own plans, his own safety, and even his own understanding in order to follow unreservedly the path that the Lord had traced out for him. The Lord calls to all of us too to follow him in our own way, to walk with Him in faith and humility within the particular circumstances of our own lives. Hail, Guardian of the Redeemer,  
Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary.  
To you God entrusted His only Son;  
in you Mary placed her trust;  
with you Christ became man.

Blessed Joseph, to us too,  
show yourself a father  
and guide us in the path of life.  
Obtain for us grace, mercy, and courage,  
and defend us from every evil. Amen.
