## Parish News

In this Sunday's Gospel reading, the Lord begins to explain to His disciples that He will suffer, die, and rise after three days. St. Peter pulls Christ aside and rebukes Him for saying this, and then Jesus responds with these very forceful words: "Get behind me, Satan. You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do." Despite all of his good intentions, Peter was still looking at life from a very worldly perspective rooted in self-interest and self-preservation. Of course, this way of thinking is simply incompatible with the spirit of the Gospel, which is why the Lord goes on to say, "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me." And yet, how often do we still find ourselves living according to the logic of the world? To what extent are our values and priorities and choices shaped by a society dominated by self-interest, rather than by the sacrificial love revealed on the Cross? Let's resolve to spend more time with the Lord, so that we can learn from Him how to think and love always with the mind and heart of God.

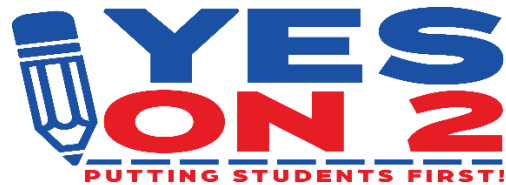
#### **Diocesan Pro-Life Mass**
