This Sunday we celebrate the solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. The Church's doctrine of the Trinity might seem complicated to some, but nevertheless it remains one of the most fundamental elements of our Catholic faith. We invoke the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit so often that it becomes very familiar to us, and yet in doing so we express an insight into God's own inner life that He has revealed to us. In fact, the Son of God became man precisely in order to draw us into that divine life. The Most Holy Trinity is no longer distant or impenetrable to us, because through Christ we have been gathered in the intimate communion of life and love between the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Today's feast reminds us that God is not abstract or impersonal; He loves us and shares His life with us now and calls us to share in it fully in eternity.

Next Sunday, we will celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi, the solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Bishop Iffert will be leading a Eucharistic procession beginning at 2 p.m. at the Cathedral and he has invited the people of our diocese to join him in that public witness to Christ our King. Please consider joining us at the Cathedral in Covington next Sunday afternoon as we adore the Lord in the Blessed Sacrament and re-commit ourselves to following Him and walking with Him always.
