This weekend is the annual DPAA Commitment Weekend. As we heard last weekend, the Diocesan Parish Annual Appeal supports a variety of ministries and services that bring the love and mercy of Christ to people in need throughout our community. The DPAA also provides us with a great opportunity to support our parish, because all funds that we raise above our parish goal are returned back to our parish without any diocesan assessment being taken out. This year we will be using our DPAA rebate to help pay for a new copper steeple for our church.

Our parish goal this year is \$43,500. This goal is about \$6,000 higher than last year's goal, which we met and exceeded, so I am confident that your generosity will enable us to do so once again. Even more than the total amount raised, I've been very proud of our parish's high participation rate in this annual appeal, which is a testament to our parishioners' widespread dedication to our parish. If you haven't been able to give to the DPAA in the past, I encourage you to please make a gift this year, knowing that any contribution—no matter the amount—will be a blessing for our parish and for those served by the DPAA-funded ministries.

In addition to being available in the pews this weekend, pledge envelopes will be in the vestibule of the church in the weeks ahead—you might also receive one in the mail from the diocese. Please remember that your gift may be spread out over the course of the next year; it's not necessary to pay it all upfront. If you need any assistance in making your gift, please don't hesitate to contact our parish office or the diocesan Stewardship Office.

Thank you, once again, for your faithful generosity and dedication to our parish. I'm truly grateful for it and I know that it's a testament to your faith and your love for Christ, His Church, and our parish. Thank you for so faithfully continuing to offer that witness.
