In fact, the Son of God became man precisely in order to draw us into that divine life. The Most Holy Trinity is no longer distant or impenetrable to us, because through Christ we have been gathered into the intimate communion of life and love between the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Today's feast reminds us that God is not abstract or impersonal; He loves us and shares His life with us now and calls us to share in it fully in eternity.
