Looking Back at Over 175 Years!

To commemorate over 175 years of being a parish, we will continue the weekly column from Chuck Taylor to “look back” at the rich history of our church community.

1853: Jacob Leis and Susanna Steffen were married. Witnesses- Peter Steffen and Anna Guhl

1869: Andrew Reitman died at age 50 from pneumonia

1870: Marianne Blenke, daughter of Michael Blenke and Catherine Enzweiler, died of typhoid fever

- 1871: Maria Heeb, daughter of Jacob Heeb and Maria Kort, was baptized. Godparents- Aloysius Futscher and Suzanna Kort. Young Maria died, the following day of pneumonia.
- 1871: Peter Steffen died at age 89. He was the oldest parishioner at that time.
- 1897: Johann Koeninger and Frances Wagner were married. Witnesses- Peter Rebholz and Magdelina Ritter
- 1906: Stanislaus Reitman, son of Nicholas Retiman and Maria Anna Weiss, was baptized. Godparents- Johann and Philomena Wagner
- 1917: John Koetting and Magdelina Walter were married. Witnesses- August Koetting Jr. and Lucia Walter
- 1926: Ambrose Sandfoss, son of Bernard Sandfoss and Philomina Siemon, was baptized. Godparents- Henry and Mary Siemon.
