This coming week, on November 1<sup>st</sup>, we celebrate **All Saints Day**, which is a holy day of obligation. On the Solemnity of All Saints, we celebrate not only the saints officially recognized by the Church, but also all the faithful from every time and place who carried out God's will on earth and live with Him now in Heaven. In a homily for All Saints Day, Pope Benedict XVI explained the meaning of the feast day in this way: "This, then, is the meaning of today's Solemnity: looking at the shining example of the Saints to reawaken within us the great longing to be like them; happy to live near God, in His light, in the great family of God's friends. Being a Saint means living close to God, to live in His family. And this is the vocation of us all, vigorously reaffirmed by the Second Vatican Council and solemnly proposed today for our attention." What we celebrate on All Saints Day is the vocation of every member of the Church: to become a saint, to share God's life. So, as we approach this important feast, let's thank God for all His saints, especially those who are closest to us, who are great examples of holiness and powerful friends who support us with their prayers as we follow Christ.
