To be certain, the Kingdom of Heaven exists in its fullness only beyond this life. We live in a fallen world that bears the scars of sin. But that doesn't mean that we should think of the Kingdom only as something distant and remote, a place of rest and reward after the hard labors of life on earth. No, the Lord makes it clear in these parables that the Kingdom of Heaven is coming to be even now, that it is already being established in our world. And so, the mission of His Church, our mission, is not simply to wait in passive expectation for a better life after this life, but to do our part now in building up His Kingdom on earth. We'll all do that in unique ways according to the particular gifts and talents entrusted to us. But at its heart our mission is the same: to let God's will be done in our lives, so that He may reign in us and through us.
