Because the pope is the universal shepherd of the Church, the whole Church celebrates the anniversary of the dedication of his cathedral.

We ask our Lord to strengthen him in his ministry of safeguarding the Church's unity and proclaiming Christ throughout the world. He reminds us that God does not abandon us, but continues to watch over us and care for us through the shepherds that He appoints to lead us in the name of His Son.
