## Parish News

St. Paul exhorts us in our second reading at Mass this Sunday: “If you were raised with Christ, seek what is above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Think of what is above, not of what is on earth.” He’s concerned that, as we make our way through this life, we don’t forget who we are and where we’re going. We have been “raised with Christ.” We share His life and we’re destined for His Kingdom. That means that our priorities, concerns, and choices have to be different from those of the world. Our lives should in every respect reflect our Heavenly citizenship.

In this Sunday’s Gospel reading, we hear about the rich man who spends his life storing up riches and treasures for himself, but then dies before he can enjoy it. In the end, he finds that while he was wealthy in what matters to the world, he was utterly impoverished in what matters to God. This is the tragedy that befalls us when we forget that we’ve been “raised with Christ” and begin to live as though we have no home beyond this world.

Let’s ask God this week to help us to remember who we are and where we’re going, so that we might spend our effort and energy not in building up treasures that pass away, but in advancing His Kingdom in our world and in our lives.
